



Carlton Jubilee Group

Notes from the Carlton Jubilee Group Meeting held on the 23 March 2022 at 7.30pm, in the Methodist Church School Room

In Attendance; Councillors Mann, Bell, Clayton, Quinn and Taylor; a WI representative; Rainbow and Brownie's representatives; and Carlton Primary School Representative.

1. Programme of Events

Feedback was received from the WI Rep:

The WI would put the knitted bunting around the Golden Gardens for the weekend event. They also offered to support the village events by doing tea/coffee/baking etc.

Feedback was received from the Primary School Rep:

There would be three Art competitions: preschool and reception classes – design a crown; school years 1-6 medal design; and school years 7-11 design a stamp. Entry forms would be available from the school, via the school hub, or could be collected from the school. The closing date for the competitions: **Friday 27 May 2022.**

Prizes would be awarded to the top 3 from each group and it was suggested that a £5 commemorative coin, in a display case (costing £10 each) would be awarded to the winners. A grant application form was provided to the parish council, for consideration at the council meeting, for £150.00 to include photocopying, the coins and medals. Medals would also be provided with red/white and blue ribbons. It was suggested that the competition is judged by the village Art Group. A letter would be sent to the Art Group and they would liaise with the Primary School to agree a day for judging. (Hopefully Saturday 4 June) All entries would be displayed in the Village Hall on Saturday 4 June 2022.

Feedback from Neil Wilde:

St Mary's Church would be unable to put on a concert in the Church. However Mr Wilde would play and entertain local residents at his home on Broadacres Avenue, on Thursday 2 June. Time to be confirmed. Anyone from the village would be welcomed and any donations towards the entertainment would go to charity.

It was suggested that a concert, of local musicians/artists could be put on at the village hall on the Sunday afternoon. An enquiry would be made to the village hall committee at the April meeting.

Group Banners

The meeting discussed banners, to invite the village groups to make a banner, from whatever material it wished, 6ft x 2ft to be displayed at the Golden Gardens on Sunday 5 June 2022. A letter would be sent to all the village groups to see if they would be interested in taking part. It would also be promoted on the parish council's website and on Facebook.

7.30pm – 11.30pm 70's Glam Rock Band to entertain in the Village Hall.

Actions:

- Advertise the cake competition, to be held at the coffee morning at the Methodist Chapel

- To contact the village hall about Brownies/Rainbows making bunting for the village hall and whether a concert could be held in the hall on Sunday afternoon or evening
- Advertise the Banner event – on Facebook and parish council website, noticeboard, shops etc
- Parish council to produce a flyer for the weekend event

The weekend of events would be promoted on the parish council's website, local community Facebook page, on the local radio and word of mouth in the village. Flyer to be printed and circulated around the village asap.
