Clerk's Report on Matters since the Parish Council meeting held on 25th April 2023

1. Cemetery

- i) The memorial for the ornate cross memorial has now been re-set; photographs have been issued to the council by email previously.
- ii) As emailed, an alternative option for the repair & repointing of the cemetery walls is to use non-lime mortar which would drastically reduce the cost to the Parish and fulfil the requirements to ensure the walls are safe and extend their longevity.

2. Local Issues, News and Updates

- i) The old noticeboard key safe is now in action and a number of community groups have already added to it.
- ii) A member of the public emailed to notify of the outer casing of the waste bin near to Woodside Bungalow & Dukesfield House, High Street, Carlton being damaged and in need of replacing. I believe this is a pole mounted bin and would cost c. £150.00 from SDC
- iii) Two reports on two faded and/or damaged street name signs (Lynwith Court and Ivy Close) have been forwarded to NYC Highways who will assess and replace as appropriate if required.
- iv) A member of the public emailed with concern regarding the activity at Lynwith Lane traveller site, as construction works was being carried out.

Cllr M Jordan assisted in this point raising it with the planning officer, who investigated. The landowner had confirmed that he was intending to erect gates to prevent flying tipping which has occurred recently on his land. The member of the public was informed of the findings.

3. Allotments & Gravel Hole Field Rental

- i) All plots in the allotment area are now rented out. One payment is still due and will be received by the end of the month; this is the last tenant to sign the agreement, which was within the last week.

Recommendation to council: That

the council consider the option of non-lime mortar to repair the cemetery walls to substantially reduce costs; and

the council consider replacing the pole mounted waste bin reported as damaged, on High Street, Carlton.
