Clerk's Report on matters since the Parish Council meeting held 30th April 2024.

1. Cemetery

- i) One interment occurred in May 2024, with the addition of associated revenue from a burial plot purchase. £875.00 of revenue has been invoiced, and payment is yet to be received into the Council's bank account.
- ii) A survey regarding cemetery plot taken and free space was received from North Yorkshire Council, and completed. It was to ascertain the free space in an open cemetery and the future plan should the space be totally used.

2. Allotments

The tenants have all been invoiced for 6 months or a year's rental, dependant on their agreement. One of the nine tenants is yet to settle their invoice; a chasing email has been issued.

3. Local Matters

- i) A member of the public raised an issue of multiple vehicles parking on the roadside around the Lynwith Lane, Carlton area, leading to some residents being unable to access their house driveways. The resident was advised to contact the Community Policing Dept. via the 101 number to report the issue of non-access.
- ii) A member of the public emailed to raise the issue of broken road drain grates in the Fairfield estate. The resident had recently fallen due to a broken grate. It was advised to contact the North Yorkshire Council Highways Dept. to highlight the issue for urgent attention. The clerk also contacted Highways to inform them of the issue.
- iii) A resident has requested that dog waste bin/s been purchased and placed within the Broadacres estate.

Recommendation to Council: That consideration is made to providing dog waste bin/s in the Broadacres area of the village.
