Clerk's Report on matters since the Parish Council meeting held 25th November 2025.

i) Cemetery

- There was one interment on 22nd December 2025 carried out by J Puntton & Son, at an Income vale of £300.00 – this payment is still out-standing and has been chased.
- A member of the public reported that a flower vase has 'disappeared' from the family burial plot. No news has been received on this; however the plot is adjacent to the front wall so could be result of pranks by person/s waiting for public transport.
- A member of the public has queried the lack of a memorial area to place plaques within the cemetery.

ii) Finance

- The Parish Council has received £1089.82 into its current account from Community Infrastructure Levy funds from NYC, which is still available to allocate to infrastructure projects.
- Harmony Energy/ Rusholme Wind Farm funding has been invoiced for £1000.00 as instructed, which will cover the works completed to refurbish the Golden Garden and allow for Spring bulbs purchases when appropriate for planting.
- Virgin Money has emailed to notify the Parish Council that the interest rate for the cash management (savings) account is to reduce from 1.25% to 1.10%

iii) General

- Verbal communication was received from a member of the public to request that thanks were passed on to Carlton Village Hall for a 'Pensioners' event, which was held in December 2025, as she wished to convey her thanks and appreciation. She 'does not so computers!'
- As reported on the Community Facebook page, it was reported to the Police that the Parish Christmas Tree had been severely damaged by vandals, with the top section of the tree being cut through. Thanks be given to M. Holmes and his team who secured the tree, which lasted out the festival period.
- A communication received notes that mud on the road and surface damage (not tanker related) has been reported to NY Highways for Linwith Lane (between the railway crossing and Race Lane). They have set a work task to address this asap.
